

NOTICE INVITING APPLICATIONS/NOMINATIONS FOR APPOINTMENT OF THE FIRST VICE-CHANCELLOR OF THE INDIRA GANDHI NATIONAL TRIBAL UNIVERSITY, A CENTRAL UNIVERSITY TO BE ESTABLISHED AT AMARKANTAK IN MADHYA PRADESH

The Indira Gandhi National Tribal University Act, 2007 has been enacted by Parliament to establish and incorporate a teaching and affiliating University, by the name of Indira Gandhi National Tribal University at Amarkantak in the State of Madhya Pradesh, to facilitate and promote avenues of higher education and research facilities for the tribal population in the country. It is proposed to appoint the first Vice-Chancellor of the University out of a panel of not less than three persons recommended by a Search-cum-Selection Committee constituted by the Central Government. The first Vice-Chancellor shall hold office for a term of five years from the date on which he enters upon his office, or until he attains the age of seventy years, whichever is earlier.

2. As the Vice-Chancellor shall be the principal executive and academic officer of the University, the incumbent of this office must have sound administrative acumen besides being an eminent academician. He must be a person with a vision and foresight to lead the University in its formative years. Besides, he should have a deep concern for the cause of tribal welfare. Preferably, he should not be more than sixty-five years of age. All things being equal, a person belonging to the Scheduled Tribes shall be given precedence over others.

3. Those interested in applying, or nominating other person(s), for consideration by the Search-cum-Selection Committee, may send their applications/nominations, along with detailed bio-data, to Shri S.S. Mahlawat, Under Secretary, Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Room No.503, 'B' Wing, Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi – 110 001, within a period of thirty days.
