Subject : Reconstitution of zones for State representation on the Board of Governors of IITs.

As per Section 11 (c) of the Institutes of Technology Act, 1961 Board of Governors of IIT, inter-alia, includes one person nominated by the government of each of the State comprising the zone in which the institute is situated. As per explanation given below Section 11 (c) the expression "zone" means a zone as for the time being demarcated by All India Council for Technical Education for the purpose of this Act. Recently, the University of Roorkee has been converted to an Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) and added as the seventh IIT to the IIT system. Moreover, three new States namely, Uttarachal, Jharkhand and Chhattisgarh have been formed. This has necessitated reconstitution of zones. Accordingly, zones for State representation on the Board of Governors of IITs have been reconstituted in consultation with the AICTE taking into account principles of contiguity and avoidance of duplication in the manner given below :-
