### **National Bal Bhavan as an Institution**

National Bal Bhavan was founded by the first Prime Minister of India Pandit Jawahar Lal Nehru in 1956. It functions as a creative resource centre for children in the age group of 5-16 years irrespective of their gender, caste, creed, colour, category or class, wherein a tension free environment is provided to the children to do activities as per their liking.

There are 53 Bal Kendras located in far flung areas of Delhi. These Kendras cater to slum children, children from remand homes, resettlement colonies and Municipal Corporation Schools. National Bal Bhavan has one Rural unit called Jawahar Bal Bhavan, Mandi. 72 Bal Bhavans are functioning all over the country. The objectives of the Bal Bhavan, are to enhance the creative potential of children and to inculcate in them a scientific temper and spirit to challenge, to experiment, to innovative and to create. The Bal Bhavan philosophy believes in activity oriented and non-formal way of learning in a playway method of learning by doing.

### **Activities undertaken by the National Bal Bhavan**

The above objectives are achieved through myriad activities encompassing a wide spectrum of subjects like *Integrated Activities, Publication, Performing Arts, Creative Arts, Physical Education, Photography, Science, Museum, Library, Home Management etc.*

### **Duties and Responsibilities**

The Director, National Bal Bhavan will exercise an over all administrative and financial control of National Bal Bhavan, Jawahar Bal Bhavan, Mandi and 52 Bal Bhavan Kendras which have been established in different parts of N.C.T. of Delhi. He/She will function as Member Secretary of the Board of Management of National Bal Bhavan and authenticate all the orders and decisions taken by it from time to time. He/she will provide all help to State Govts. who are desirous of setting up Bal Bhavan on the pattern of Central proto-type Bal Bhavan. The Director will exercise such powers and discharge such duties as are laid down in the Rules and Regulations and Bye-laws of the National Bal Bhavan.
